### INTERPRETATION:-

#### **POTASSIUM:**

Potassium is the major cation in the intracellular fluid. 90% of potassium is concentrated within the cells. When cells are damaged, potassium is released in the blood.

#### **HYPOKALEMIA (LOW POTASSIUM LEVELS):-**


- 1.Diarrhoea, vomiting & malabsorption.
2. Severe Burns.
- 3.Increased Secretions of Aldosterone


#### **HYPERKALEMIA (INCREASED POTASSIUM LEVELS):-**

- 1.Oliguria
- 2.Renal failure or Shock
- 3.Respiratory acidosis
- 4.Hemolysis of blood
