SPECIMEN INFORMATION/RECEIVED:

Gastric antrum biopsy

GROSS EXAMINATION:

- 1.Received (in formalin) three whitish soft tissue fragments, aggregate measuring 0.3x0.3x0.2 cm.
- 2.Entire tissue is submitted for processing in 1 cassette.

MICROSCOPIC EXAMINATION:

- 1.Sections examined show gastric antral mucosal fragments.
- 2.There is mild disarray of foveolar architecture.
- 3.There is mild to moderate chronic lympho-plasmacytic inflammatory in lamina propria.
- 4.No neutrophilic activity is present.
- 5.No atrophy is noted.
- 6.There is no evidence of granuloma, intestinal metaplasia, dysplasia or malignancy.




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7.Occasional small curvilinear bacilli are present in the mucus clinging to the foveolar epithelium, morphologically suggestive of *Helicobacter pylori*.

INTERPRETATION/RESULT:

Chronic antral gastritis without activity. Occasional H. Pylori organisms present.

Recommended correlation with clinical, endoscopic and H. pylori serological investigation findings
