## Remarks:

HIV - DUO determines the presence of HIV p24 antigen and antibodies to HIV -1 group and HIV-2.

- It is a screening test. All Reactive results are crosschecked by immunochromatography method and ELFA, reported as per 2. NACO guidelines.
- 3. All Reactive results need to be confirmed by alternate methods, like Western Blot.
